

Testing Can Uncover Hidden Health Problems In Your Pet

We may screen for some of the following conditions in determining your pet's health status.

TEETH

Dental exams uncover mouth infections, which may cause secondary problems with vital organs.

THYROID

Biochemistry and serum T₄ tests can indicate hypothyroidism or hyperthyroidism.

HEART

Immunosay tests can indicate heartworm disease. Biochemistry tests can indicate cardiac damage.

LIVER

Biochemistry tests can indicate:

- Liver disease
- Cushing's syndrome
- Certain cancers
- Dehydration
- Obstruction of the bile ducts
- Abnormalities resulting from long-term medications

PANCREAS

Biochemistry tests can indicate:

- Pancreatitis (inflammation of the pancreas)
- Diabetes mellitus
- Abnormalities resulting from long-term medications
- Cancer

KIDNEY

Blood and urine tests can indicate:

- Early renal disease
- Renal failure
- Infection
- Stones
- Cancer
- Abnormalities resulting from long-term medications

BLOOD

CBC/Hematocrit are used to screen for:

- Anemia (low red blood cells)
- Inflammation
- Infection
- Stress
- Leukemia
- Bleeding problem
- Inability to fight infection
- Hydration status
